WHERE: In front of the main grandstands

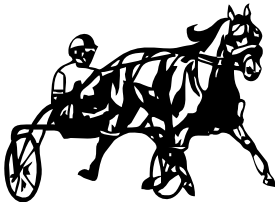
The object of this event is to pop the balloons that will be attached to the Power Wheel by the Derby committee!!!

Power Wheels Derby Rules:

1. Kids 4-9 years old on day of show may participate. Kids will be broken up into 2 age groups: 4-6 and 7-9. Each heat will be timed. Last one with a balloon is the winner. Every participant will receive a prize!!!
2. Entry fee is \$10 on or before July 1. Entries received after July 1 will not be guaranteed a t-shirt. A parent or legal guardian must sign a liability waiver form upon check in on Friday, July 19.
3. Any regular electric standard sized Power wheel is allowed. It must be a "sit in" not "sit on" style!!! Child's legs must be inside the compartment. 1 child per vehicle...no passengers!!

4. Power Wheels may be decorated as desired but **NO STRUCTURAL MODIFICATIONS MAY BE MADE TO THE VEHICLE!!!!** A 12 volt battery may be used but it must be secured under the hood and away from the child. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut using zip ties, duct tape or other flexible products. Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from breaking but no additional traction may be used. Any vehicle deemed unsafe or altered will not be allowed to compete. All decisions made by the fair board members in charge are official!! **Please, remember that this is for the kids so do not do anything to their vehicle that will disqualify them because you will be the one to deal with your disappointed child!!!!**
5. Seat belts are recommended but not mandatory.
6. A helmet must be worn at all times...bicycle, football or racing styles are all acceptable as long as they are secured to the child's head.
7. All Power Wheels must be checked in at the pit gate between 4 and 6 p.m. for inspection and impounded until show time. Liability waiver must be completed at this time.
8. 1 adult and the participating child will be allowed on the track/pit area at the time of the event. All others are to remain in the grandstands unless additional pit passes are purchased. Please listen for the PA announcer to call you to the track.
9. Child must remain inside the power wheel during the event. If they exit the vehicle they are disqualified.
10. If the vehicle has more than one speed, then low speed must be used.
